Meaningful Use Stage 2 Modifications Rule still at OMB

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has still not released the Meaningful Use Stage 2 Modifications Rule, even though Oct. 3 is anticipated to be the last day for eligible professionals (EPs) to begin reporting in 2015 in order to avoid a penalty in 2017. The proposed Modifications Rule, released in April, outlined a number of changes, including a 90-day reporting period for EPs, a decrease in the number of measures to be reported and reduced measure thresholds for both the secure messaging and view, download or transmit requirements. The OMB website states that the Stage 2 modifications rule has been coupled with the Stage 3 final rule. MGMA and others have asked for the Stage 3 rule to be decoupled and delayed.
